PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Elliott Heads Surf Life Saving Club members have completed another season of patrolling our beach and competing at the various carnivals and championships. The season has been quite successful with strong placings at local events through to the Australian Titles. In addition, internal projects have been completed.

A fourth patrol group was again formed for the season providing a little more time away from the beach between patrols. As expected, difficulties were experienced with patrolling numbers during carnival weekends due to a large number of our juniors and seniors competing.

Again this season we had a number of members reach an age where SRC and Bronze medallions were able to be achieved. We also were fortunate to have several senior members complete the training to also hold these levels of qualification. A special thanks to our Training Officers, Rick Wootton and Trevor Harvey, for providing the training to these members to enable their Awards to be achieved. In addition, several members gained further achievements including IRB Crewies, IRB Drivers and various First Aid certificates as well as officials and water safety qualifications.

The previously approved grant for the construction of our gear shed was completed during the season by Ian Winning of Carwin Homes and this additional space has proven invaluable for easy access and safer passage through the clubhouse. After a few teething issues with our Can-am, it has settled in and proving to be a good workhorse to drag the trailer and IRB's around. Several other smaller grants enabling the purchase of boards and necessary equipment have also been completed.

I will advise everyone of the program dates once I have confirmed and booked these in and would love to see our regular helpers as well as those who would like to volunteer for a what is a rewarding experience for all involved. A fun time is had by all.

As those newer to the club may not be aware, our club cannot operate without the support of those who choose to volunteer their time and expertise in various roles. The many hours our patrolling members spend on our beach, our coaches, Junior Activities Coordinator and age managers training our nippers on a Sunday morning and attending carnivals, those who provide water safety or officiating, our training officers for their time spent enabling members achieve their SRC, Bronze, IRB Crewies, IRB Drivers and various levels of first aid. Our lovely ladies of the canteen who keep us from starving and our management committee for making sure everything continues to run in the background.

There are so many members/parents who complete many jobs around the club that make a big difference. Such as cleaning of the pathways and toilets, repairing of the IRB motors, plumbing repairs, replacement of light globes and smoke detector batteries, just to name a few. CHIEF TRAINING OFFICER REPORT 2018-19

The 2018-19 season was reasonably busy due to the number of new Bronze Medallion and Surf Rescue Certificate holders to be put through. It was great to see so many new faces willing to take on wearing the red and yellow for the club and the swelling of numbers to patrol groups was gratefully received. Branch run courses continued throughout the season, including quite a few members either gaining for the first time or refreshing their First Aid Certificates and updating their ART Award.

Unfortunately, the Federal government introduced changes to the legislation regarding Registered Training Organisations and this has affected all current trainers and assessors statewide. It was determined that all assessors would be required to undergo an upgrade of modules to be able to continue to assess. Completing this upgrade has put a dent in our ability to continue to run courses in the off season, therefore the IRB Crewman and IRB Driver course plans have had to be put on hold until this could be completed. We will be discussing plans going forward for holding these now in the coming season and also for encouraging interest in club members stepping up to take on roles as trainers and assessors.

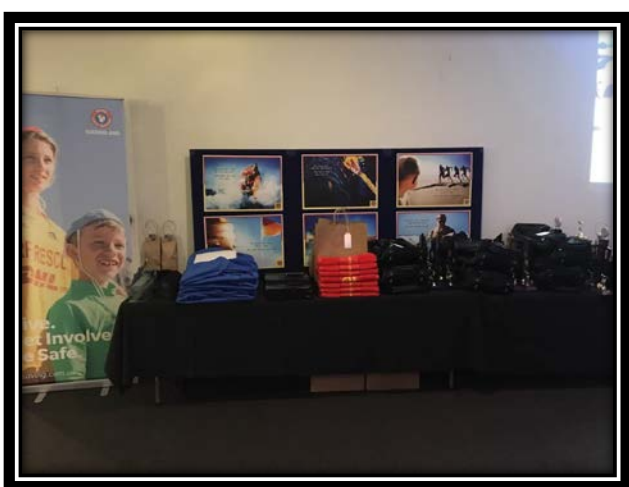

SURF SPORTS REPORT 2018-19

With the surf sports season officially wrapped up for 2018/19 we look back on an outstanding competition season for Elliott Heads Surf Life Saving Club. While club participation and 'having a go' have always been our focus in regard to surf sports, involvement at every level should be congratulated. Our philosophy has always been participation and the enjoyment of lifesaving backed up by hard work and training, and this is evident in quite a large number of serious competitors at our relatively small club.

As a club we send a broad range of competitors to both junior and senior carnivals. We compete in every competition format not just beach and water events, which most people associate with surf sports. We continue to attract and encourage strong participation at all of our local 4-point carnivals and Branch Championships. As a club we also send strong contingents to local and further afield pool rescue events and our continued support of our Branch Surf Rescue Championships continues to attract a small but dedicated group of younger athletes. This year has seen families once again travelling the length of the state to uphold the traditions of Team Elliott.

The next thing that I would like to do is thank our small but dedicated group of coaches that have spent the time training and preparing our athletes for the season that was. Elliott Heads offers coaching outside of the normal Nipper program for opportunities in Pool Rescue, Beach and Water Events and Champion Lifesaver with qualified coaches providing quality instruction throughout the season. While the coaches run and motivate our athletes these sessions couldn't take place without the competitors themselves and the parents that provide water safety. I would like to therefore thank all the members that put effort into developing and nurturing our surf sports competitors in any way, shape or form.

Elliott Heads has always sent relatively large numbers of competitors to most carnivals, particularly our smaller local events. However, as a club, at times our support staff hasn't always been as large as it could be or we have had to rely on one or two people, too often, to cover our commitments in this regard. As a club this year we have been gratified to see a larger number of associate members completing their SRC or Bronze Medallions so they could provide water safety. Surf Sports Official numbers have also grown this year to a good level so that we can spread the load over a very long and varied season. This influx of dedicated and motivated individuals will help to alleviate the rush and panic to fill support quotas before each and every carnival. While it is good that we encourage maximum participation at carnivals and do not want to exclude any competitor from having a go, these ratios should be taken into consideration first and shouldn't be the last things to be considered when nominations are being compiled for carnivals as we do not want to burn the enthusiasm of our members because we have to turn away or cap our participation numbers to suit the number of support personnel that we can provide on the day.

Over the year Elliott Heads sent competitors to every local carnival, Branch and State Championship and even to nationals. While it would be inappropriate and unrealistic to mention every individual competitor and their performances, I would like to - on behalf of the club - congratulate and thank every athlete from the state gold medallist to the young boy or girl that is competing for the first time, on their results and efforts during the season. Our Branch Championships are generally the carnivals that most of our athletes work hard to compete at and once again Elliott Heads' athletes didn't disappoint. At the senior carnival held at Bundaberg Surf Lifesaving Club we placed second overall on 444.2 points and took out handicap honours. Our masters who competed at the same carnival, placed first overall but handicap honours went to Bundaberg this year. The Junior Branch Championships hosted by the Tannum Sands Surf Lifesaving Club was attended well and our athletes placed third overall on 457 points and ultimately



took out handicap honours as well. Elliott Heads successfully hosted the Branch Surf Rescue Championships this season which saw small numbers travelling from around the Wide Bay Capricorn area to compete in: Champion Lifesaver, First Aid and Patrol Teams competitions. Once again, our club had members participating in the Champion Lifesaver events with pleasing results overall, however none of our competitors chose to advance to State. We did however take out the Kerry Collins Surf Rescue Handicap Champion shield. This is just a taste of the successes that we have achieved over the season, and on behalf of the Elliott Heads SLSC I would like to congratulate all our surf sports competitors both young and old for participating in this 2018/2019 season. The goal of our club has always been to provide our members with the skills and opportunities to compete both at home and on the bigger stage.

However, our team cannot compete without a very special group of volunteers. Our surf sports officials who stand on the beach all day in baking heat and driving rain, our water safety personnel, who are often the parents of our competitors, standing ever vigilant and our Team and Age Managers who make sure competitors are where and when they need to be. These club members travel to these competitions without pay or any form of remuneration and our club owes them a huge vote of thanks.
